OPPOSING LUTON AIRPORT EXPANSION



Bim and Cllr Annie Brewster continue to campaign to limit further growth of Luton Airport. They have met with the Head Commissioner from the Independent Commission of Civil Aviation Noise, who is raising the profile of aviation noise as a public health issue.

Annie is currently Vice-Chair of the London Luton Airport Consultative Committee. She says "It is vital that we keep our voices heard and that we continue to press for a reduction in traffic, not an increase."

OUR PRIORITIES

- 1 Dealing with traffic issues. Residents' concerns about traffic along the Lower Luton Road continues to be a priority. We are also working to improve safety at the roundabout junction of the Lower Luton Road, Lamer Lane, Codicote Lane and Station Road.
- **2** Fighting for our Bus Services. An Inter-Parish Bus Group facilitated by Cllr Sandra Wood saved the Sunday service for this current year. We will continue to monitor bus services and encourage District Council support. Residents are urged to use buses more often. It is very much a case of 'use them or loose them'.
- **3** Fixing local roads. Potholes are a continual challenge at this time of year. HCC have an ongoing programme of road repairs, footway and cycle route development. Residents should report any highways faults on: https://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/ services/highways roads-and-pavements.aspx.

SAFE CROSSING



Bim Afolami MP is working with our County, District and Parish Councillors to help St Helen's Primary School with the safe crossing of pupils on both Brewhouse Hill and The Hill.

The difficulties include the unsafe road and finding people able to take on the role of crossing patrol attendants.

Bim met with County Cllr Annie Brewster, District Cllr Gill Clark, parents and teachers in January to look at the situation first hand.

OUR PLAN GOING FORWARD

- In the short term: Following this meeting one of the school's crossing attendants has returned to her post and another candidate has been interviewed for the other vacant post.
- 2 In the longer term: Permanent pedestrian crossings will be needed on both Brewhouse Hill and The Hill, where the pupils need to access the school gates. Bim is supporting Annie's call to Hertfordshire County Council to install Zebra Crossings for the safety of both the pupils and the wider Wheathampstead community.
